Grace at the Green Light Executive Director, Sarah Parks, underscored the importance of the partnership by saying, "This partnership with Healthy Blue Louisiana could not have come at a more critical time.

Their support is helping us expand our services and meet urgent needs among the unhoused population. It's a testament to what's possible when organizations work together with empathy and foresight to uplift entire communities."
